<u>Online Safety</u>

Keeping children safe whilst they are online is no easy thing. There are always new apps coming out and sites springing up which are attractive to children but potentially can put them at risk. Some such apps are musical.ly, lol, reblok, Askfrank, ask.fm and Sayat.me. These apps appear harmless fun but are open to anyone and you are unable to monitor or limit who accesses them or posts on them; potentially putting them at risk from online bullying and paedophiles. It is important to keep a regular check on what apps your child is downloading and what sites they are visiting at all times.

Stranger Danger

We have been informed that a child from one of our neighbouring schools was approached by a man in a car after school and asked if they would like a lift. Please always be aware of where your child is, who they are with and what they are doing and report any suspicious behaviour.

Infection Control

Parents have been asking us what is the procedure to follow or how long does their child need to be off when they have been poorly.
